The following are FAQs that will be on the ticketing site and also on a confirmation email that will go out to all ticket holders 2 days prior to the service where they have a ticket...

Q: What is Experience Christmas at Bayside?

A: Experience Christmas at Bayside this year with your family and friends. Q: How long is the service?

A: Approximately 75 minutes.

Q: Is there assigned seating?

A: You can choose from 2 ticketing options. Reserved seating and General Admission. Reserved seating tickets are \$5 each and guarantee you an assigned seat. General Admission seats are first come, first serve.

Q: When are tickets available?

A: Tickets will be available online Monday, November 28th until they are sold out.

Q: Where can I purchase Tickets?

A: Tickets can be found online at www.baysideonline.com or at any of the Bayside Granite Bay Weekend Services.

Q: Is there assigned seating?

A: Yes, you can purchase an assigned seat for \$5 and all proceeds go to Bayside Christmas Cause's.

Q: Where do I park?

A: You can either park on campus at Bayside or ride the Bayside Shuttle. The Bayside is located at Olmypus and East Roseville Parkway.

Q: Will there be a Will Call?

A: Ticket solutions is located at all Bayside Campus's during weekend services and at the Granite Bay campus during the Special Christmas Services.

Q: Which services have ASL (American Sign Language)

A: Friday, December 16th, 2016 at 7:00pm. A section is reserved for those needing ASL and their families.

Q: What time should I arrive?

A: We suggest you arrive 1 hour prior to your service starting time.

Q: What time do the doors open?

A: The doors will open 30-45 minutes prior to the service start time

Q: Where do I go if I reserved an ADA ticket?

A: Once you enter the campus please look for and follow signs for the ADA entrance, located in the East Lobby. Each person with an ADA ticket may have one person accompany them. Due to space we ask the rest of the party wait in their appropriate line.

Q: Do I have to print my tickets?

A: To make the lines move more efficiently we would appreciate it you print your tickets. Mobile tickets will also be accepted.

Q: Does my child need a seat?

A: Any child who is 3 and older will need their own seat.

A: Yes, we are open weekends! Bayside services will continue the 17th and 18th. The 7pm service on December 18th will be replaced with the Christmas Eve Service!

Q: Will we be having regular services as well?

A: On the Weekend of Dec 17th-18th, We will have regular weekend services Saturday at 4:15pm, Sunday at 8:15, 9:45, and 11:30am. There will be no Saturday 6pm service or 7:00pm on Sunday night.

There will be no regular services at Granite Bay on December 24th as we are having five (5) Christmas Eve Services that day.
