

2023 ICHTHUS MUSIC FESTIVAL CAMPING RULES & REGULATIONS

September 15 & 16, 2023

CHECK-IN

In order to check in, you must have your confirmation number with you or know the name under which the site was registered.

Camping areas will begin checking in campers on Friday, September 15 from 3PM-8PM and Saturday, September 16 at 10AM-6PM.

CHECK-OUT

Camping areas will close Sunday, September 17 at 11AM. Please “police” your camping area and be sure to take your trash with you or to the dumpster.

AVAILABLE CAMPING OPTIONS

Primitive Sites | \$15 per person for two nights
(two free, age 11 and under, camping spaces with each adult camping space purchased)

Primitive Sites with no electric or water hookups. Sites approximately 20'x20'.

Primitive RV/Popup Sites with no electric or water hookups. Sites approximately 20'x40'.

GENERAL CAMPING INFORMATION

NO SHOWERS WILL BE AVAILABLE.

Porta Potties are available.

No dumping of sewage is allowed.

Camping area will be mowed.

Campfires are not permitted.

Trailers are permitted on the campsites. Your trailer must fit onto your site with no part outside that border.

There are a few water spigots randomly located within the camping area.

Each camping site will try to have enough room for awnings and slides to be used.

Generators are permitted at your site. We ask that all generators be turned off by 11pm.

Camping is located within walking distance of the festival.

SET-UP

If you check-in before Friday evening activities begin, we strongly encourage you to stay in the campground area. For your safety and for the ease of festival set up, please remain in the campground until the grounds open at 5PM.

PARKING

ICHTHUS will allow one vehicle per site to be parked next to your campsite. All other vehicles must be removed from the campground area after set-up and parked in general parking, which is in close proximity to the camping grounds.

PERMITS

Camping permits must be visible and placed in the vehicle parked at your site as well as on all RV's and tents located in the campground. Bring your online confirmation, you will receive your permits upon check-in. Make sure your cell-phone number is written on the camping permit/camping parking pass.

QUIET HOURS

We ask you to be courteous to all and adhere to quiet hours from 12 midnight - 7AM . However, please understand there are NO guaranteed quiet areas on-site for campers. This is a festival atmosphere with many youth attending and camping.

BANNED ITEMS

No alcohol, illegal drugs, or fireworks are allowed.

TARPS & BLANKETS

ICHTHUS will not allow tarps or blankets to be placed anywhere in the stage area of the festival grounds prior to the start of Friday evening or Saturday morning until the main stage area is open. If any items are in these areas prior to the start of the festival, they will be removed and taken to lost and found at the information booth.

FOOD/COOLERS

Please keep all personal food items and coolers at your campsite. Per our agreement with food vendors, these items will NOT be allowed at any other areas of the festival grounds.

PETS

Pets are not allowed in the primitive area. Pets are NOT allowed on the festival grounds. Service animals may be allowed but be prepared to show proper documentation that they are service animals and/or remove animals if they (1) do not respond well to loud music and noise likely present at the festival and/or (2) there are any issues with any other campers. If you do have a service animal, please be courteous to your fellow campers and clean up after

them. If you are asked to remove a service animal there will be no refund on tickets or camping should you decide to leave the festival.

RE-ENTRY

All campers are required to have their ICHTHUS ticket (wristband) beginning Friday evening after check-in. This wristband is your ticket for the entire weekend. If lost or broken, a new ticket can be purchased at full price at the festival gate.

DRESS

No immodest clothing, swimsuits, etc.

MAIN GATE OPENS

Main Gate opens Friday at 3:00PM, and Saturday at 10:00AM.

ICHTHUS MUSIC FESTIVAL tickets and camping are nonrefundable.

LIABILITY WAIVER AND RELEASE OF CLAIMS

By attending ICHTHUS Music Festival, you agree to:

DUTY TO SELF-MONITOR:

Participants and volunteers agree to self-monitor for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 (symptoms typically include fever, cough, and shortness of breath) and, contact ICHTHUS if he/she experiences symptoms of COVID-19 within 14 days after participating or volunteering with ICHTHUS.

RELEASE AND WAIVER.

I HEREBY RELEASE, WAIVE AND FOREVER DISCHARGE ANY AND ALL LIABILITY, CLAIMS, AND DEMANDS OF WHATEVER KIND OR NATURE AGAINST THE ICHTHUS MUSIC FESTIVAL, THE BEACON FOUNDATION, SERVANT HEART FARM AND ITS AFFILIATED PARTNERS AND SPONSORS, INCLUDING IN EACH CASE, WITHOUT LIMITATION, THEIR DIRECTORS, OFFICERS, EMPLOYEES, VOLUNTEERS, AND AGENTS (THE "RELEASED PARTIES"), EITHER IN LAW OR IN EQUITY, TO THE FULLEST EXTENT PERMISSIBLE BY LAW, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO DAMAGES OR LOSSES CAUSED BY THE NEGLIGENCE, FAULT OR CONDUCT OF ANY KIND ON THE PART OF THE RELEASED PARTIES, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO DEATH, BODILY INJURY, ILLNESS, ECONOMIC LOSS OR OUT OF POCKET EXPENSES, OR LOSS OR DAMAGE TO PROPERTY, WHICH I, MY HEIRS, ASSIGNEES, NEXT OF KIN AND/OR LEGALLY APPOINTED OR DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVES, MAY HAVE OR WHICH MAY HEREAFTER ACCRUE ON MY BEHALF, WHICH ARISE OR MAY HEREAFTER ARISE FROM MY PARTICIPATION WITH THE ACTIVITY.

ASSUMPTION OF THE RISK. I acknowledge and understand the following:

Participation includes possible exposure to and illness from infectious diseases including but not limited to COVID-19. While particular rules and personal discipline may reduce this risk, the risk of serious illness and death does exist;

I knowingly and freely assume all such risks related to illness and infectious diseases, such as COVID-19, even if arising from the negligence or fault of the Released Parties; and

I hereby knowingly assume the risk of injury, harm and loss associated with the Activity, including any injury, harm and loss caused by the negligence, fault or conduct of any kind on the part of the Released Parties.

MEDICAL ACKNOWLEDGMENT AND RELEASE. I acknowledge the health risks associated with the Activity, including but not limited to transient dizziness, lightheadedness, fainting, nausea, muscle cramping, musculoskeletal injury, joint pains, sprains and strains, heart attack, stroke, or sudden death. I agree that if I experience any of these or any other symptoms during the Activity, I will discontinue my participation immediately and seek appropriate medical attention. I DO HEREBY RELEASE AND FOREVER DISCHARGE THE RELEASED PARTIES FROM ANY CLAIM WHATSOEVER WHICH ARISES OR MAY HEREAFTER ARISE ON ACCOUNT OF ANY FIRST AID, TREATMENT, OR SERVICE RENDERED IN CONNECTION WITH MY PARTICIPATION IN THE ACTIVITY.

As a participant, volunteer, or attendee, you recognize that your participation, involvement and/or attendance at any ICHTHUS event or activity ("Activity") is voluntary and may result in personal injury (including death) and/or property damage. By attending, observing or participating in the Activity, you acknowledge and assume all risks and dangers associated with your participation and/or attendance at the Activity, and You agree that: (a) The ICHTHUS Music Festival, The Beacon Foundation, and SERVANT HEART FARM (b) the property or site owner of the Activity, and (c) all past, present and future affiliates, successors, assigns, employees, volunteers, vendors, partners, directors, and officers, of such entities (subsections (a) through (c), collectively, the "Released Parties"), will not be responsible for any personal injury (including death), property damage, or other loss suffered as a result of your participation in, attendance at, and/or observation of the Activity, regardless if any such injuries or losses are caused by the negligence of any of the Released Parties (collectively, the "Released Claims"). BY ATTENDING AND/OR PARTICIPATING IN THE ACTIVITY, YOU ARE DEEMED TO HAVE GIVEN A FULL RELEASE OF LIABILITY TO THE RELEASED PARTIES TO THE FULLEST EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW.
